



## M102 West Footscray to Yarraville Water Main Renewal Project

Melbourne Water is committed to enhancing life and liveability in West Footscray, Kingsville and Yarraville; and we work hard to ensure you're kept up to date with what we're doing locally. Renewing the 80 year old M102 Water Main will help to secure a reliable water supply for the growing suburbs in western Melbourne.

### Works to begin July 2018

From early July 2018, Melbourne Water will start works to renew the last 2 kilometre section of the M102 Water Main between West Footscray and Yarraville.

Upgrading this important piece of infrastructure will involve:

- Constructing a new 900mm diameter water main between Paramount Road, West Footscray, and Williamstown Road, Yarraville.
- Reinstating work sites as close as possible to pre-construction conditions along the pipeline alignment.
- Disconnecting and decommissioning the existing pipeline that runs underneath Somerville Road.

**The majority of works will take place from Monday to Friday between 7:00am and 6:00pm, and on Saturday between 7:00am and 1:00pm (when required).** Outside of these times quiet activities such as cleaning-up or office duties will be undertaken.

**Construction works will commence in early July 2018** and will take approximately six months to complete (weather permitting).

Due to peak water demands during the summer months, the construction crew will return in late March 2019 to carry out connection and decommissioning works. These works will take approximately two months to complete.



## What's happening & when

While construction is underway, some changes to traffic conditions will be required to help us carry out our works safely and with as little disruption as possible.

You may experience some congestion and minor delays as works move along the alignment. **Speed limits will also be reduced to 40km/h during construction.**

The water main renewal work will be carried out in three project locations:

**Section 1:** Starting at the intersection of Paramount Road and Somerville Road, works will east along Somerville Road, turning into Kororoit Street, crossing Geelong Road and finishing at the corner of Angliss Street and Kidman Street. These works will commence early July 2018.

**Section 2:** From the intersection of Angliss Street and Kidman Street, works will head east along Kidman Street, across Roberts Street and into Charlotte Street. Moving through Cruickshank Park and across Stony Creek, construction will then travel north along Julian Street and finish at the Somerville Road intersection. These works will commence late September 2018.

**Section 3:** Beginning at the intersection of Julian Street and Somerville Road, works will continue east along Somerville Road until Queensville Street. Some construction will also occur at the intersection of Severn Street to prepare for connections with another water main at this location. These works will commence early July 2018.

We thank you in advance for your patience as we carry out this essential upgrade work.
